



Recommendations: things to buy for your new puppy



Grooming:

- Slicker brush with beads on the end of the bristles- Mikki easy grooming ball pin slicker
- Metal comb- Can get cheap from Amazon
- Mars coat king- Will only be needed if dog ever gets matted
- Nail clippers- Pets at Home dog claw clippers

Bedding:

- Large crate
- Dog pen (useful to corner an area of the house for puppy)
- Dog mattress/bed- remember puppies get dirty colours will get stained- if you can find beds that are more indestructible go for that. Land sharks chew so keep that in mind.
- Towels/blankets

Training:

- Puppy pads for those little accidents or you can by litter trays (however the pups should be well on their way with toilet training)
- Treats - wainwrights, smartbones, natures menu (or use cooked chicken/hot dogs as high reward treats)
- Snuffle mat- Amazon
- Treat games/puzzles- lots online
- Extra clicker

Toys

- Balls on ropes- particularly if you want to do flyball this will help in the future
- Nylabones
- Kongs- don't buy the spray paste as its so unhealthy
- Teething toys for dogs- (tip - wet flannels rolled and placed into freezer pups love this for chewing when they are teething)
- Lick mats - enrichment toys

Harnesses – you may want to wait until pup is fully grown and use collar and lead in the meantime.

- Ruffwear
- 3peaks
- Fit into everyway

I do NOT recommend the Julius K9 as it goes across their chest so be weary particularly if you're doing agility or flyball as it can restrict movement and can cause injuries in the dogs. (We have one that we use on Sansa but take it off her when she is running/exercising)
